Energy Minister Announces New Energy Conservation Framework



Richmond Hill, Ontario, June 2, 2014 – ENERGY NETWORK SERVICES INC. would like to inform that current lighting retrofit incentives programs will only be available for a limited time. According to the Toronto Hydro Spring 2014 Newsletter, the Electricity Distributors Association (EDA) has developed a new six-year conservation framework for electric utilities which will commence on January 1, 2015. EDA believe this change will empower utility companies to deliver more cost-effective and customer-centric conservation programs. The goal of this new conservation framework is to put the responsibility in the hands of local utilities who are best equipped to deliver the province's conservation needs.

This change will also affect the current program incentives. It is said that this year is the last year, as of November 2014, that incentives for lighting retrofits from T12 to T8 lamps will be available. As a result, ENS advises all companies wishing to upgrade their lights to be proactive and take advantage of this incentive before it is too late. The retrofit does not have to take place this year, however to qualify for the incentive, applications with Ontario Power Authority needs to be submitted before November 2014.
